



**LETTER OF INTENT
FOR SCIENTIFIC AND ACADEMIC COOPERATION
between
THE UNIVERSITY OF MELBOURNE, AUSTRALIA
and
HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA**



In accordance with a mutual desire to promote international cooperation between Australia and Indonesia, the University of Melbourne and Hasanuddin University has joined in this letter of agreement to foster an academic relationship through mutual cooperation in research. No financial obligations are assumed under this agreement.

Each institution will designate an individual to coordinate this program and all endeavors that may derive from it. For this purpose, The University of Melbourne designates Professor Patrick Kwan of the Faculty of Medicine Dentistry and Health Sciences, and Hasanuddin University designates Doctor Upik Anderiani Miskad of the Faculty of Medicine.

The University of Melbourne and Hasanuddin University have reached agreement on the following areas of research cooperation, subject to mutual consent and the availability of sufficient funding:

- I. The University of Melbourne agrees to the provision of research leadership and stewardship, technical guidance and input, and liaison with funding agencies as required
- II. Hasanuddin University agrees to provision of local advocacy, contextual guidance, network development, and human resource development

Both sides agree and consent to the following areas of academic cooperation, subject to mutual consent and the availability of sufficient funding:

- I. Exchange of faculty joint research activities
- II. Participation in seminars and academic meetings
- III. Exchange of academic materials and other information

The terms of such mutual assistance and funding for any specific program and activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of a particular program. Both Institutions understand that financial arrangements for all types of cooperation and exchange shall be negotiated on a case-by-case basis and will depend on the availability of funds.

No amendment, consent, or waiver of terms of this Letter of agreement shall bind either party unless in writing and signed by all parties. Any such amendment, consent, or waiver shall be effective only in the specific instance and for the specified purpose given.

It is understood that this Letter of Agreement represents a statement of principles of the interaction between the Institutions and is not a legally binding document.

The University of Melbourne and Hasanuddin University subscribe to the policy of equal opportunity and do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, age, ethnicity, sexual preference, religion, national origin, or disability. Both Institutions shall abide by these principles in the administration of this agreement.



However, the other party must receive such notification at least one month prior to the effective date of termination.


