Today, Monday, twenty sixth of June, two thousand and seventeen, has been made a Memorandum of Understanding,

BETWEEN

1. Junichi Hamawaki M.D., Ph.D., as a Director, on behalf of Hamawaki Orthopaedic Hospital, located at Hiroshima Japan, hereinafter referred to as **THE FIRST PARTY**

AND

2. Prof. DR. Andi Asadul Islam, M.D., as a dean, on the behalf of **FACULTY OF MEDICINE HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY** located at Makassar, Indonesia, hereinafter referred to as **THE SECOND PARTY**.

INTRODUCTION

Faculty of Medicine Hasanuddin University and Hamawaki Orthopaedic Hospital have come to an agreement to cooperate and form one memorandum of understanding (later will be stated as this memorandum) to work together in many field such as training on residents and orthopaedic surgeon, to reach the higher quality of Orthopaedic Staff Faculty of Medicine Hasanuddin University.

Article 1

SCOPE OF COOPERATION

Both parties will cooperate in transfer technology and knowledge as well as exchange experiences and specialties in orthopaedic related field of education and training programmes information technology and others.

Article 2

GOAL OF COOPERATION

1. This cooperation is established to achieve high quality of orthopaedic resident and orthopaedic surgeon of Orthopaedic Department Faculty of Medicine Hasanuddin University.
2. To establish a relationship between Orthopaedic Department Faculty of Medicine Hasanuddin University and Hamawaki Orthopaedic Hospital.

Article 3

ROLES OF EACH PARTY

1. Both parties in this memorandum agreed to handle all the task as good as possible and carry out their own responsibilities equally without losing benefits of any sides.
2. All form of cooperation in education field, training programmes, treatment, hospital/ clinical management and others that will be performed cooperatively between both parties has to be discussed and agreed by representative of both sides.

Article 4

MISUNDERSTANDING SOLUTION

All differences of misunderstanding between both parties in this memorandum have to be settled by or through negotiation and will the spirit of friendship and unity.

Article 5

AMENDMENTS

Amendments to this memorandum can only be made after consultation an mutual consent from the parties.

Article 6

DURATION

This memorandum shall be effected from the date of signing and be valid for the duration of two year from that date, and will be automatically renewed on an biennial basis thereafter unless terminated or replaced with another alternative memorandum of understanding.

Article 7


TERMINATION
